Our priorities for Ealing are:

Addressing over-development

In common with so many residents of Ealing, we are concerned that small, unaffordable flats in tall towers do not help to address the housing issues of the Borough, and have a negative effect on the quality of life of those living near them. We would push for stronger action on planning, including holding developers to the goals set in Ealing Council's own Climate Strategy.

We would also push for changes to the planning process to give local residents more say in what happens in their area.

Reducing air pollution

Reducing the number of short car journeys is essential to reducing air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions. We are passionate about cycling, and want to see joined up schemes that make it more accessible. But we also need pleasant places to walk, safe places to cross, and the best possible public transport provision.

Protecting urban green spaces

Warren Farm is a crucial site in the Borough for biodiversity. We are working with local campaign organisations to call for it to become a Local Nature Reserve.

We know there is so much more to be done. The balance needs to shift to make the sustainable choice easy and affordable.
